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
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
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Do you believe the District should increase or decrease the frequency of curbside recycling?




Q9 \bigcirc Would you support curbside food waste/ compostable





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

Would you support the sale of portions of the lands purchased by the District to a developer for future development?



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
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

Is the affordability of housing and/or the availability of affordable housing in Invermere something that would make you consider leaving the community?



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
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

Based on the question above, what range of tax increase would you support each year for the next 5 years (2021-2025)?




