Our mandate is to develop and enhance opportunities for 40 Chartered Communities by implementing culturally relevant social and economic programs and services.






Columbia Valley Métis Association (CVMA)

The Columbia Valley Métis Association (CVMA) is the local Chartered Community organization associated with MNBC whose service area include Spillimacheen, Brisco, Radium Hot Springs, Invermere, Wilmer, Athalmere, Panorama, Windermere, Fairmont Hot Springs and Canal Flats.

As of June 2023, the CVMA services 176 registered MNBC Citizens.





Project Vision

MNBC, in collaboration with CVMA, have developed this proposal which is envisioned to support the Métis community in Invermere through new rental homes and cultural gathering space.



Rental Homes

The proposal includes approximately 36 rental homes to address the urgent housing needs of the Métis community in Invermere.



CVMA Community Building

The proposed CVMA building will serve as a community hub, providing a space for cultural gathering and events, office space for CVMA, and easier access to services and programs for the Métis community.
